## **CUMBERLAND TRACE**






As westward migration increased, communities developed along the Cumberland Trace. In 1785, settlers built McFadden's Station on the Cumberland Trace near the Barren River approximately where 1-65 crosses the Barren River) as a "rest stop" for travelers.
